REPORT ON IKS EXCELLENCE PROGRAM-2026 **Shri Gnanambica Degree College (A), Madanapalle**

Shri Gnanambica Degree College (A), Madanapalle, organized the IKS Excellence Program-2026 with the objective of encouraging students to explore, understand and express the values and wisdom embedded in Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS).

The poster announcing the Intra-College IKS Excellence Program-2026 was formally launched on 05 August 2026, marking the beginning of the initiative. Online registrations were opened on 14 August 2026 and closed on 17 August 2026, providing students and faculty members an opportunity to register for the various IKS-based activities. The Painting Excellence Program was scheduled for 24 August 2026, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, followed by the Essay Writing Excellence Program on 25 August 2026, from 9:00 AM to 10:30 AM. The Morale Story Telling Excellence Program was scheduled over 25 and 26 August 2026, from 11:00 AM onwards, enabling the participants to present their creative expressions based on Indian Knowledge Systems and their associated values.

A distinctive feature of this initiative was its approach towards excellence rather than competition. The program was deliberately designed to encourage students to complement and learn from one another rather than view their peers as competitors. Therefore, the word "competition" was consciously avoided throughout the program, and the activities were presented as Excellence Programs.

The initiative provided students with opportunities to express their understanding of IKS through painting, essay writing and moral storytelling.

Events and Participation

Three Excellence Programs were conducted:

1. Painting Excellence Program

The Painting Excellence Program provided students an opportunity to express IKS-related ideas, values and themes through visual creativity. A total of 64 students registered, while approximately 29 students actually participated.

The recognition of excellence was as awarded to:

- 1st Prize – Mr. T Jayaprakash Reddy , BCA AI
- 2nd Prize – Miss. Shaik Siya Fathima, BCA AI

2. Essay Writing Excellence Program

The Essay Writing Excellence Program encouraged students to reflect upon IKS themes and present their understanding through meaningful written expression. A total of 95 students registered, while approximately 40 students actually participated.

The recognition of excellence was as awarded to:

- 1st Prize – Miss. Sagatala Halma, BSC CS
- 2nd Prize – Miss. Shaik Khatijathul Kubra, BBA

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3. Morale Story Telling Excellence Program

The Morale Story Telling Excellence Program provided students with an opportunity to communicate values and life lessons through storytelling. The activity encouraged students to connect traditional wisdom with contemporary life and personality development. A total of 48 students registered, while approximately 40 students actually participated.

A Culture of Complementarity :

The underlying philosophy of the IKS Excellence Program was to create an environment where students complement one another rather than compete with one another.

Every student possesses a different ability, perspective and form of expression. One student may excel in visual expression, another in writing, while another may communicate ideas effectively through storytelling. Recognizing these differences and appreciating one another's strengths was an important part of the program.

For this reason, the institution intentionally adopted the term “Excellence Program” instead of “Competition.” The purpose was not to create a mindset of *winning over others*, but to encourage every participant to discover, develop and demonstrate his or her own excellence. The prizes therefore served as recognition of exceptional achievement, while the participation of every student was valued as an important contribution to the collective learning experience.

Outcome

The IKS Excellence Program–2026 successfully provided students with a platform to engage with Indian Knowledge Systems in creative and practical ways. Through painting, essay writing and moral storytelling, students were encouraged to observe, think, reflect, create and express.

The program also supported the development of creativity, communication, confidence, value consciousness, self-reflection and personality development, while promoting the spirit of mutual appreciation among students.

The initiative stands as an effort to make Indian Knowledge Systems a living and experiential part of student development, rather than limiting them to theoretical learning.

Conclusion

The IKS Excellence Program–2026 was successfully conducted with encouraging participation from students. With 207 registrations and approximately 109 actual participants, the program created meaningful opportunities for students to express their understanding of Indian Knowledge Systems.

The institution's decision to focus on excellence, complementarity and mutual appreciation rather than competition gave the program its distinctive character and reinforced the broader IKS objective of developing not merely knowledgeable students, but balanced, confident and value-oriented individuals.
